**ORDER:**

The following notification will be published in the Telangana Gazette, dated:08.09.2022.

**NOTIFICATION**

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India and in supersession of the Special Rules issued in G.O.Ms.No.219, PR & RD (Estt-III) Department, dated:11.06.2008, and as subsequently amended from time to time, and adapted to the State of Telangana, the Governor of Telangana hereby makes the following Special Rules for the Telangana State Mission Bhagiratha Engineering Services:-

**RULES**

**1. SHORT TITLE:**

(1) These rules may be called the Telangana State Mission Bhagiratha Engineering Service Rules, 2022.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their Publication in the Official Gazette.

**2. CATEGORIES:**

The service shall consist of the following categories of posts, namely:-

**Note-1:**

(1) On the basis of necessity and requirement, the Government will finalize the cadre strength of each category of Telangana Mission Bhagiratha Engineering Service. In the case of Assistant Executive Engineer the cadre strength will be determined on the basis of Presidential Order. Further, for the Assistant Executive Engineer / Assistant Engineer, the overall sanctioned strength will be considered as cadre strength. However, the vacancies as notified by the department from time to time shall be filled in the ratio of 3:1 respectively.

(Example: If 200 vacancies of Assistant Executive Engineer / Assistant Engineer are notified at a time, 150 vacancies will be filled up by Assistant Executive Engineer and 50 by Assistant Engineer pertaining to the Telangana Mission Bhagiratha Engineering Subordinate Service Rules. Out of 50 vacancies of Assistant Engineers, 35 will be filled up by direct recruitment and remaining 15 by promotion from the cadre of Assistant Technical Officer or conversion from Technical Officer.).

(2) Accordingly, the department shall send proposal for recruitment of Assistant Executive Engineers and Assistant Engineers to the Telangana State Public Service Commission.

(3) In case, direct recruitment of Assistant Executive Engineers is made in a particular year, the eligible Assistant Engineers who are appointed by transfer as Assistant Executive Engineers after completion of 6 years of service shall be placed below/above the directly recruited candidates of that particular year based on the date of communication of PSC selection list to Engineer-in-Chief (MB). If the selection list by Public Service Commission is communicated to Engineer-in-Chief (MB) on a particular date, all the Assistant Engineers appointed by transfer as Assistant Executive Engineer before that date will be placed above the direct recruit Assistant Executive Engineers and vice-versa.

**NOTE-2:**

The direct recruitment to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer shall be made among the degree holders in Civil/ Mechanical/ Electrical/ Instrumentation/ Computer Science/ I.T. to the extent of the requirements of the Department. There shall be separate channel for further promotions for the different categories for the streams other than civil Engineering as mentioned above.

**Note:** The vacancies in the category of Non-Technical Personal Assistant to the Engineer-in-Chief / Chief Engineer shall be filled by prescribing the ratio 3:2 in a cycle of every 5 vacancies by maintaining two separate seniority lists for Superintendents of the Office of the Head of Department and for Superintendents of Circle Offices.

- (III) Engineer - in Chief office
- (IV) Circle Office
- (V) Engineer-in- Chief Office

**4. RESERVATION OF APPOINTMENT:**

- (1) Rule 22 and Rule 22-A of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 as amended from time to time shall be applicable for the Direct Recruitment.
- (2) Local reservation shall be applicable as per provisions of the Telangana Public Employment (Organization of Local Cadres and Regulation of Direct Recruitment) Order, 2018.

**5. QUALIFICATIONS:**

(a) No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories specified in column (1) by the method specified in column (2), unless he/she possesses the qualification specified in the corresponding entry in column (3) below:-

(1) The Bachelor's degree in engineering of above mentioned disciplines should be from a University in India established or incorporated under a Central Act or State Act or an Institution

recognized by the University Grants Commission / All India Council for Technical Education or Associate Member of the Institution of Engineers.

(2) The number of posts to be recruited in each discipline mentioned above will be decided at the time of recruitment by the department based on the requirement / necessity.

## 6. AGE

Rule 12 of the Telangana State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996 as amended from time to time shall be followed for direct recruitment.

## 7. PROBATION:

- (1) Every person appointed by direct recruitment to any post in this service shall, from the date on which he/she commences probation, be on *probation* for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.
- (2) Every person appointed to any post, either by promotion or by transfer shall, from the date on which he/she commences probation, be on probation for a total period of one year on duty within a continuous period or two years.

## 8. MINIMUM SERVICE & ELIGIBILITY FOR PROMOTION:

Unless otherwise specified elsewhere in these rules, no

person shall be eligible for appointment by transfer or promotion unless he/she has put not less than (3) years of service in the category from which such appointment by transfer or promotion is made:-

- (i) For promotion to the cadre of Engineer-in-Chief, one should render minimum one year of service in the cadre of Chief Engineer.
- (ii) For promotion to the cadre of Chief Engineer, one should render minimum one year of service in the cadre of Superintending Engineer.
- (iii) For promotion to the cadre of Superintending Engineer, one should render minimum three years of service in the cadre of Executive Engineer.
- (iv) For promotion to the cadre of Executive Engineer from the cadre of Deputy Executive Engineer, one should render minimum five years of service in the cadre of Deputy Executive Engineer. Out of which, two years should be field service.
- (v) For promotion to the cadre of Deputy Executive Engineer from Assistant Executive Engineer, one should render five years of regular service in the cadre of Assistant Executive Engineer, out of which, two years should be field service.
- (vi) The service rendered in Investigation or Execution or O & M or Quality control etc., shall be considered as field service for consideration for promotion to the category of Deputy Executive Engineer and Executive Engineer.
- (vii) Field experience for Physically Challenged candidates is not required.

#### **9. TRAINING:**

- (1) Every person appointed by Direct Recruitment / appointment by transfer to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer as the case may be shall undergo a course of training immediately after appointment for such period and as per such programme and syllabus as may be prescribed by the Engineer - In- Chief from time to time.
- (2) A refreshing course is mandatory for the newly promoted Deputy Executive Engineers / Executive Engineers conducted by the Department.
- (3) The period of training shall count for purpose of probation, increments, leave and pension.
- (4) A Direct Recruittee shall be eligible for the initial pay of the post with usual allowances, admissible at the place of training during the period of training.

**10. TESTS:**

Every person appointed to the post of Assistant Executive Engineer by Direct Recruitment shall pass the Accounts Test for Public Works Department Officers and Subordinates within the period of probation.

**NOTE:**

Any Assistant Executive Engineer on probation shall not be discharged for failure to pass the above test within the period of his/her probation but his /her probation shall be extended and his/her increment shall be stopped till he/she passes the test.

**11. UNIT OF APPOINTMENT:**

For the purpose of recruitment, appointment, discharge for want of vacancy, seniority, promotion, transfer and posting and appointment as full members to the posts specified in column (2) of the Table below, the unit of appointment shall be as specified in Column (3) as per the Presidential Order, 2018 thereof:-
